## John C. Garand Rifle Match

**Saturday August 28, 2010**

Started in 1998 by the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP), the John Garand match was designed as an introduction to highpower rifle shooting. All skill levels of shooters are invited.

The match involves shooting from the prone (slow fire and rapid fire) and standing position. All firing is done from 200yds at a bullseye target having a 12" aiming black (target designation "SR").

Eligible rifles are the M1 Garand, 1903/1903A3 Springfield and any foreign military bolt action rifle which can be loaded with a clip or magazine. Iron sights only on ALL firearms!

30-06 is issued as part of the entry fee, and must be used by M1 and Springfield shooters. Those using foreign bolt guns will provide their own ammo. M1 Garand loaner rifles will be available for use that day (you have no excuse to stay home!).

Local and national retailers have donated prizes, and participants are eligible to win medals provided by the CMP. Everyone wins something!

**Course of fire: CMP "A" course (30 shots for record)**

**We will shoot a Garand Match followed by a Springfield/Vintage Rifle Match.**

Target pullers will be provided. No one will do pit duty!

**Pre-registration is recommended. This match will fill up quick! Please call ahead. Range capacity is 60 shooters. You are under no obligation by pre-registering!**

**Time:** Registration- 7:30am-8:45am  
Commence Firing- 9:00am

**Location:** FWRR rifle range, Harlan, IN (10 miles NE of Fort Wayne, IN)

**Entry fee:** \$30.00 for the Garand match and an additional \$10.00 if you wish to also shoot the Springfield/Vintage Match.
